Surrender Your Chairs

On October 30 and 31, WWCCR Sponsored three amazing events with Michelle Moran. Michelle's teaching was rich and all who attended these events walked away with something special from the Lord.

At the beginning of the afternoon session of the Leaders' Day, a prophetic word came forward that invited us to take a prophetic action. The word was about God inviting us to fold up our chairs and surrender them and the action was to actually do it. This was an opportunity to take a concrete step in response to an invitation that God was putting forth. Each person was to prayerfully reflect on what that might mean in their lives: Was the chair a position that they held? Was it an area that they were holding fast to but God was saying "Give it to me?" Was it a relationship? We may not know what each of the chairs represented as people brought them forth; God does!

As I had the opportunity to emcee the event, I was at the podium when each person brought forth their chairs. Initially each chair was set against the podium on each side and, as the number of chairs increased, the podium began to move because of the weight. Quickly a few people jumped into action and the chairs were stacked as you see in the photo below. What struck me about this was the result of this surrender. Each of these chairs, and whatever they represented, had a weight to them. Of course there was a physical weight, but there was also a spiritual and emotional weight as well.

As each person folded their chair, brought it forward, released it to God, and returned to find a new seat, the weight that they had been carrying could now be carried by Jesus. Wow! How often do we carry a weight that our Lord desires to carry for us? How often do we sit in the same chair while the Holy



Spirit is encouraging us to "Go!"? Ultimately, we each need to ask: "what am I prepared to lose for the sake of the Gospel?"

Many years ago, the first time I attended a national meeting, someone suggested sitting in a different chair at each session. This "changing of chairs" enabled me to look at the situation with a new perspective, from a new vantage point. As we end 2015 and move into the new year, let's invite the Lord to show us what chairs he'd like us to fold up and surrender. We can trust Him for He is faithful. And, who knows, perhaps He'll give us that new perspective in the action. •
