

## Holy Spirit Refreshment!

"Let's put on a Holy Spirit Seminar at the office!" This idea came about at a WWCCR Prayer Group and Leadership Development Committee meeting late last year. While this committee has a big name it is comprised of just a few people with hearts dedicated to sharing the grace of baptism in

the Holy Spirit and strengthening prayer groups and those who serve in them in any way necessary. "Will anyone come?" was one of the questions. We decided it was worth it, even if it was only the four of us.



In 2015 we have put on three of these Holy Spirit Seminars (hosting them quarterly), each time learning from the previous, and each time marveling at how good our God is. At the very first one we were surprised that each of the people who attended had already experienced baptism in the Holy Spirit. We thought we would be opening the doors to new people and discovered that there is a deep hunger to be refreshed in the grace that had already been received. There was one couple who came from out of state and had been involved in the Renewal for many years. As we gave the introductory talks I hoped that there would be something for them, since they probably had heard the talks many times before. What God knew, but we didn't yet, was revealed at the end of the day during the large group sharing: they received exactly what they needed – a refreshing in the Holy Spirit! They shared that this day was just what they needed in order to go back to their home and start a prayer group in their town.

The feedback that we received at that first Holy Spirit Day kept being echoed in each day we presented. What the people need the most was more of the Holy Spirit that they had already received. The evaluations had good things to say about the talks and the praise and worship, but overwhelmingly the people talked about how much the small groups meant and then the prayer ministry (which we did in small groups). It was a wonderful lesson in how the Holy Spirit works so powerfully in this small community that was built

Refreshment continued from page 1 in one day, and revealed how hungry we are for connection, both with each other and with God.

For our September Holy Spirit Seminar Day, we put up signs in the garden to invite the neighborhood. One young woman said that she and her son would come. They didn't arrive until the end of the day, after the prayer ministry time and were just there for the final talk. As Ron McNerney was sharing "where do we go from here" I hoped and prayed that there would be something for them. During the large group discussion that followed the young man spoke up saying how he felt like Ron was speaking directly to him. The witness of that young man touched all of our hearts and if the whole day was put on only so that he could hear

this message of hope at the end, then the day was worth it.

There was so much grace during each of these HSS days, and especially the most recent one in September. What we have learned is that we all need to continue to live out the call to "share with all...the grace of baptism in the Holy Spirit" encouraged by Pope Francis last year and to evangelize "with the Word of God which proclaims that Jesus is alive and loves all men." How we go about this needs to be adapted to those whom we want to reach.

We also were blessed and ministered to by each other, through the talks, the meals, and the fellowship. Sometimes doing something different, such as attending a one-day Holy Spirit Seminar, going to Dwelling Place or another event, or even visiting a neighboring prayer group, is exactly what we need to be refreshed in our life in the Spirit. Whatever we do, let's not cease seeking more of the Holy Spirit and discovering creative ways to share what we have received.


